Bishop Mark writes, "A National Eucharistic Congress will be held on Saturday 14th September 2024 at the invitation of the Bishops of England and Wales. The Congress and pilgrimage will take place at Saint Mary's College, Oscott in Birmingham, with the purpose of renewing and deepening devotion to the Most Holy Eucharist. It is noted that Oscott was the venue for the first Eucharistic Procession since the Reformation. The Congress will be on a much smaller scale than the last National Eucharistic Congress in Liverpool and we have been allocated as a diocese, 44 representatives."

As this is a small allocation, if any parishioner wishes to attend the Congress, please let us know by Wednesday 24th July by emailing our parish at sacredwil@gmail.com so that this small number of tickets can be allocated, hopefully at request and if necessary, by ballot.
